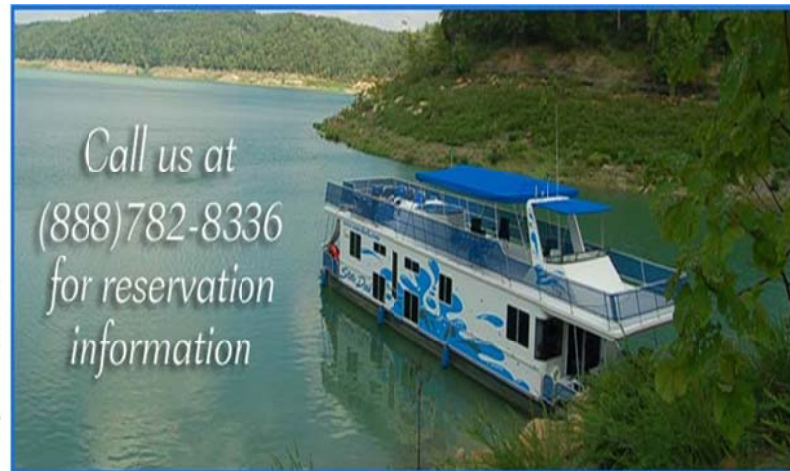
## The Bluegrass Vintage Boat Rendezvous
